FLORIDA BRIGHT FUTURES SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

The Florida Bright Futures Scholarship Program awards high school students who merit recognition of high academic achievement, meet the standards required for an award and who enroll in an eligible Florida public or private postsecondary education institution. Students must meet the eligibility requirements listed in § 1009.521, Fla. Stat. Applications for a Florida Bright Futures Scholarship must be completed after December 1st but prior to graduation of the student's last year in high school. Each high school guidance office will have specific qualifications for each component of the Florida Bright Futures Scholarship Program.

Bright Futures Scholarship – Community Service Hours. Students wishing to satisfy the Florida Statute 1009.534 requirements for volunteer hours may choose social issues of interest to them. Students must follow the guidelines below for student volunteer hours and maintain documentation for purposes of meeting Bright Futures requirements.

1. Volunteer service areas may include, but are not limited to:
 - A. Non-profit community service agencies/organizations
 - B. Public schools
 - C. Accredited private schools
 - D. Churches
 - E. Government agencies
 - F. Hospital/Medical Centers
 - G. Convalescent/Nursing Homes
 - H. Licensed Childcare Schools/Agencies
2. No pay or reward will be given in exchange for the volunteer hours.
3. School or college credit will not be awarded.
4. The activity needs to be conducted in a public place.
5. There should be no unreasonable health or safety risk involved.
6. Volunteer hours cannot be for family members.
7. The service hours cannot be political in nature.
8. There can be no solicitations for donations.
9. Documentation should include date(s) of service, description and location of service, number of hours completed, and signature of person supervising.

For graduating seniors, maintain the documentation until at least the onset of the next academic school year. For all other students, keep copies of completed service hours for at least one year after graduation.
